We have finished the time of camps in the jungle, where once again the Lord worked in the salvation of souls and the restoration of his children. In the first week in Gareno, we had about 120 kids from different communities, and in the evenings we had around 250 total, including the adults who gathered with us. In Bataburo, we had around 165 kids from various communities, and about 300 people in the evenings. In both camps, we preached the gospel, and taught from God's Word using the theme: "Jesus, the Architect of my Life." It was a time of great blessing. The teachings were well received, not only by the kids participating in the camps, but also by the people from the local communities.



We have been blessed by what God did in the camps, and also by what He did in our lives.

The camps reflected the work of a team of young people from different congregations who gave up their vacation time to dedicate themselves to serve in the jungle.
